Many women experienced the pursuit of the Lord in a way they hadn't before. And women have come into a relationship with Christ as a result of the conversations we've had this month. Thank you for praying for these women!

Just this past weekend, we stepped off campus and spent time with nearly 50 women at our annual Women's Overnighter. We spent time focusing on the truths that we are redeemed, strong, deeply loved, accepted, worthy, and beautiful — this is what our identity in Christ gives to us. Can you be praying that the women on our campuses would allow themselves to walk in these truths and experience intimacy with God?
